
We have learned recently that Unison, a nonprofit organization in Milwaukee County, has been in the news. In the last year, Interfaith Older Adult Programs merged with Set Ministries to form Unison, a nonprofit agency serving Milwaukee County. On Friday, November 23, the CEO of Unison was arrested for misappropriation of funds. We are deeply saddened to see any nonprofit organization in the news for a negative reason, and have offered our support to the leadership of Unison during this difficult time.

Many of our organization's volunteers and community partners have expressed concern and wondered if our organization is connected to Unison. Although we are an interfaith-model program, we are not formally affiliated with Unison, Set Ministries, or Interfaith Older Adult Programs. Like more than 300 interfaith-model organizations throughout the country, we provide caregiving services to seniors and adults with disabilities and are governed by a Board of Directors.


